

# Closed Captioned Video Instructions

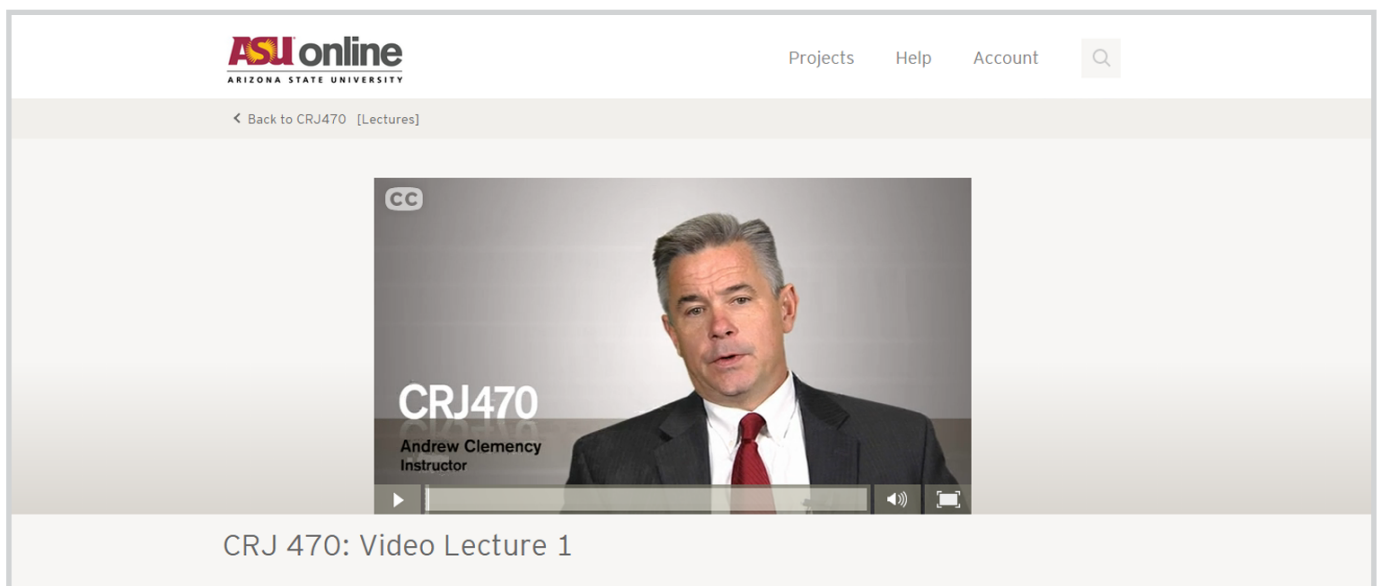
Closed captioned video is placing text on the video to provide a time synched text transcription of the video. Closed Captioning is available as approved on a case by case basis for ASU Online courses.

## Initiating the Closed Caption Feature

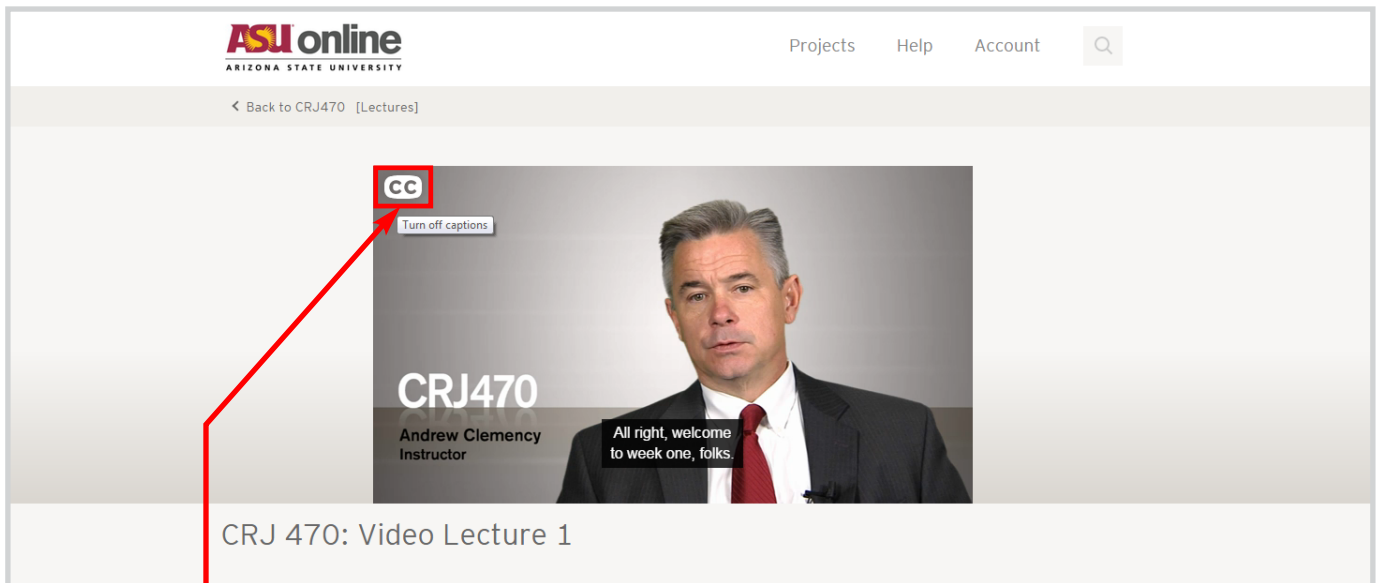
Before playing the video, when hovering over the display, the Closed Caption icon will appear.

### NOTE

The closed caption feature can be toggled on and off at any point

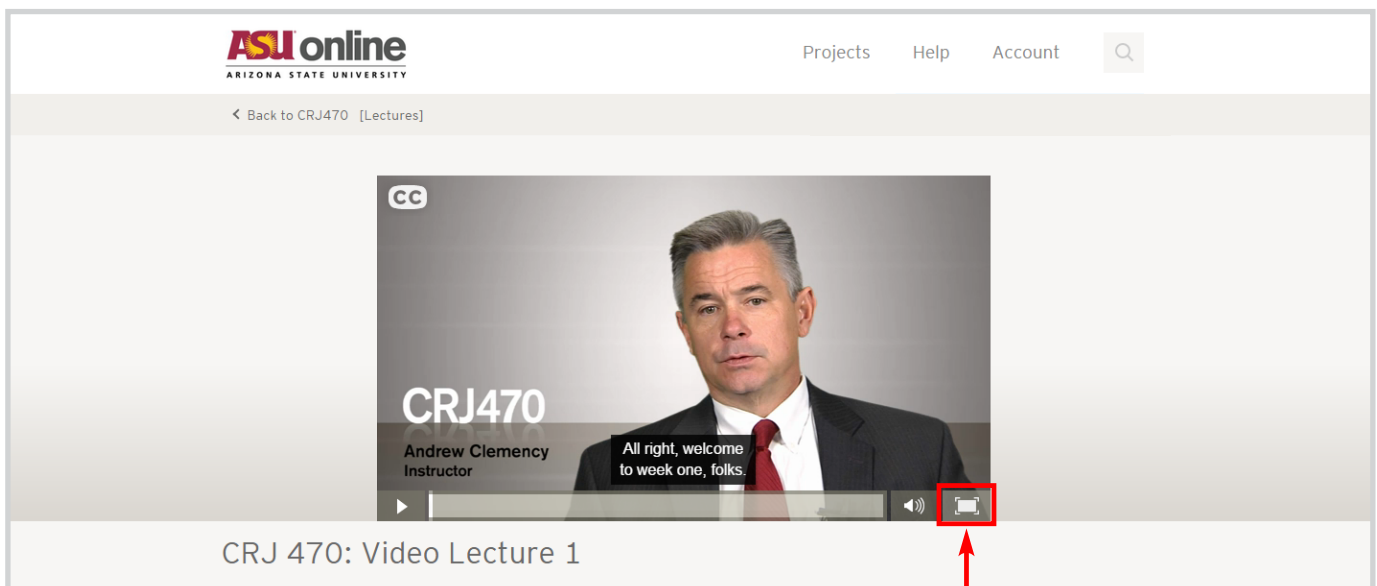


At the beginning of each video, the closed caption feature will be disabled



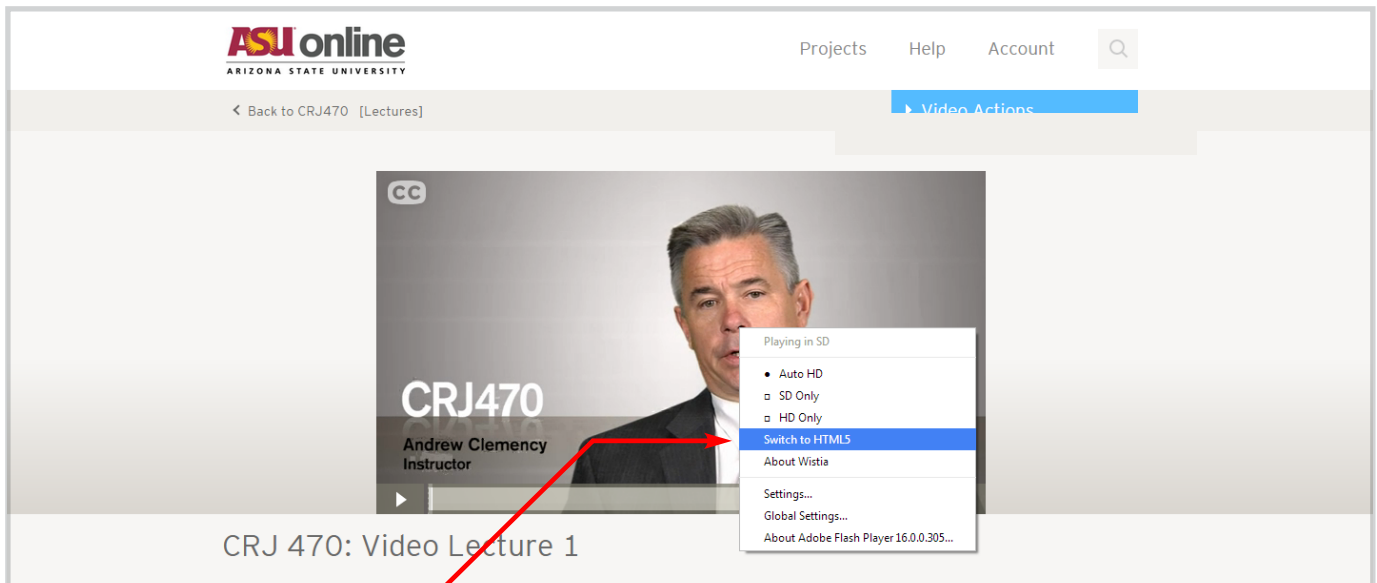
After pressing the CC button, there will be subtitles displayed at the bottom to help follow along

## Using Closed Caption in Full Screen Mode

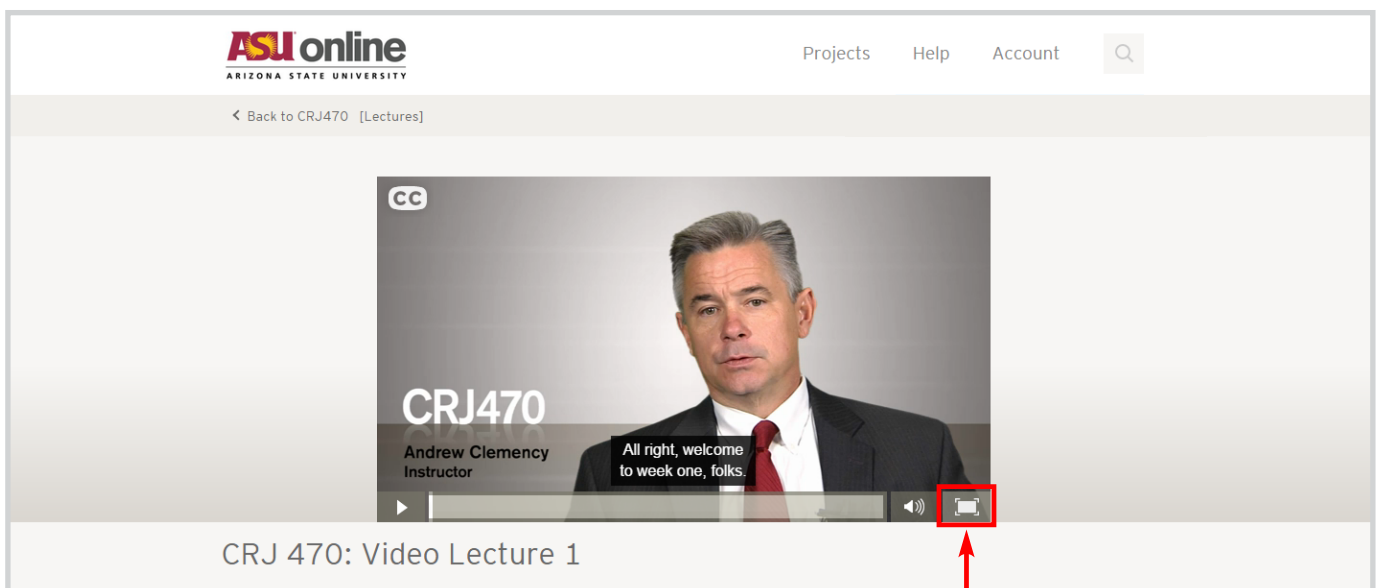


When entering full screen mode, the closed captions may vanish

For the closed caption feature to function, the video must be set to HTML 5 format



To set closed caption in full screen, before entering full screen mode, “Right Click” the display and press “switch to HTML5”



After switching, just enter the full screen mode from the bottom tab and the closed caption feature will be in effect if selected
